# **INTRODUCTION**

Food manufacturers throughout the world, invest a lot of money in designing and creating labels for their food products.

WHY?? to attract consumers.

Higher standards of packaging and labeling can significantly increase the volume of Guyana's agro-processed foods to developed countries (Noble, 2011).



# WHAT IS A FOOD LABEL?

According to the Food and Drugs Act “Food Label includes any legend, word or mark attached to, included in, belonging to or accompanying any food or package.”

# **SOME QUALITIES OF A GOOD FOOD LABEL**

A good food label will allow us to answer the following:

- ❑ What is the food?
- ❑ Where did it come from?
- ❑ Who made the food?
- ❑ What is in it?
- ❑ What quantity of food is here?
- ❑ How long will this food last?

# USES OF LABEL INFORMATION

---

- ❖ Use-by dates
- ❖ Bar-codes for product identification & stock control
- ❖ Nutritional information
- ❖ Help sales through package promotions



# MAIN COMPONENTS OF PACKAGE LABELS

1. Principal (Main) Display Panel (PDP)- refers to the surface of the package that is most prominent.

In the retail store it is displayed in front.

On a can, the PDP takes up 40% of the circumference & entire height, while on a box, the PDP occupies the entire side of the box.

# COMPONENTS OF THE PRINCIPAL DISPLAY PANEL (PDP)



Brand or Trade name

Product's common name

Graphic representing product

Net weight or contents

# MAIN PARTS OF PACKAGE LABELS (CONT'D)

## 2. Information Panel (IP)

- ✗ On a box, it's the entire side immediately to the right or back of the PDP as displayed to the consumer
- ✗ On a can, it's the 20% of the can's circumference immediately to the right of the PDP.
- ✗ Notably, when the top of a package is the PDP, any adjacent side can be the IP.
- ✗ Any required features must appear together.
  - ✗ **No graphics should be found on the IP.**
